Our Respite Care Coordinator works collaboratively with Richmond Home Health to plan for respite stay.




Our Respite Team consists of RNs, LPNs, Registered Care Aides and Social Worker to coordinate meeting the care needs of each guest

RICHMOND LIONS MANOR BRIDGEPORT – RESPITE CARE

Respite is the temporary relief from the emotional and physical demands of caring for a friend or relative.

Caregiver relief is the primary purpose of the Richmond Overnight Respite Program. We offer your loved one an opportunity to stay with us, while you have a brief period of rest and relief, so that you can continue to provide good care upon their return.



Operated by Vancouver Coastal Health Authority (VCHA) Richmond Lions Manor Bridgeport is home to 74 residents and offers five semi-private rooms (two guests per room) and two private rooms in their Overnight Respite Program.

ELIGIBILITY AND REFERRAL PROCESS

- Adults living in Richmond who are currently being cared for at home
- Caregivers in need of temporary relief from the emotional and physical demands of caring for a friend of relative
- Must be medically stable
- Must be assessed and referred by a VCH Case Manager
- Please Note: ALL medications must be dispensed from CareRx during the respite stay (dispensing fees are an additional charge)

COST

A stay at the Richmond Overnight Respite program costs \$48.20 per day. This fee is reassessed yearly (in January) by the BC Ministry of Health.

LENGTH OF STAYS

Three (3) days is the minimum stay. Guests can stay a maximum 30 days per calendar year and return home at the end of each stay.

Note to Caregivers
Respite should be confirmed
PRIOR to finalizing travel plans

ROOMS

Room types include two single occupancy rooms and five double occupancy rooms. While every effort will be made to ensure same gendered room this cannot be guaranteed. Each guest will have a bed, bedside table, dresser and a washroom that is shared by the occupants of the room.



BENEFITS

- Assistance with personal care and daily living activities
- Recreational and social programs that enable guests to remain active and socialize with one another
- Personalized care plans, meals and health monitoring
- Access to spiritual care, music therapy, an outside courtyard, and family lounge areas
