What are Councils in LTC?

Councils in Long Term Care (LTC) are organized groups of residents, family members, friends and representatives of residents, who meet on a regular basis to work together to enhance the quality of life of residents. All councils are intended to be self-led, self-determining and democratic.

There are three different types of Councils:

Family Councils - comprised of families, friends and representatives of residents.

Resident Councils - comprised of residents.

Resident and Family Councils - comprised of residents, families, friends and representatives.

A LTC home may have more than one type of Council and each may have a different focus. Each care home is required to provide support and resources as requested by their Council(s).



VCAFC - Who We Are

families and care home operators, to develop
mutually beneficial relationships between Family
Councils and care home management.

Our mission is to raise awareness of the role of independent LTC Family Councils in the Vancouver Coastal Region of BC. Our goals:

- 1. Establishing new Family Councils;
- Providing education and support to existing Family Councils;
- Facilitating transitions to independently, family-led councils while strengthening partnerships with long-term care home operators;
- 4. Advocating for family and residents in LTC.

VCAFC is a proud member of the <u>Independent Long-Term Care Councils Association of BC</u> (ILTCCABC), our provincial association of long-term care councils. VCAFC is one of five member regional associations who comprise ILTCCABC.





VCAFC - What We Do

VCAFC helps family members start new Family Councils and is an ongoing support and resource.

VCAFC mentors families about roles and expectations of Family Council executive members.

VCAFC educates on best practices and provides templates and resources to help councils get set up to run independently and collaboratively with senior leadership.

VCAFC works with LTC staff and management to educate them about how they can best support Family Councils.

VCAFC informs residents and families about residential care regulations and guidelines.

VCAFC meets monthly to share and discuss lived experiences with the common goal of improved quality of care and life for residents.

VCAFC serves to elevate the voices of resident and family councils through sharing at regional forums and in meetings with the Ministry of Health.

CALL to ACTION!

Do you have a Family Council? We encourage you to find out! The management team at your care home can provide you with information on whether or not a Family Council exists at your home. If no council exists, we are here to help you get one started. If you already have a Family Council, VCAFC is here to support you!

- VCAFC provides support and mentorship to new and existing Family Councils.
- VCAFC hosts educational sessions on topics meaningful to Family Councils.
- 3. **VCAFC** offers networking, sharing and problem solving through bi-monthy forums.
- 4. **VCAFC** elevates the voices of residents and advocates to our provincial association, <u>ILTCCABC</u>, which meets with the Ministry of Health on a regular basis.
