Nursing Anne Simulator Info Sheet



Airway

- Spontaneous breathing
- Oropharyngeal airway (OPA), nasopharyngeal airway (NPA), supraglottic insertion
- Trach care and suctioning
- Endotracheal intubation
- Anterior & posterior lung sounds

Assessment

- BP palpation & auscultation
- Heart, lung, bowel and vocal sounds
- Palpable anatomical landmarks
- Normal, dusky and infected stoma available

Pulses

- Bilateral carotid, brachial, radial, femoral and pedal pulses
- Do not press forcefully when palpating pulse points or no pulse will be felt

Fluids may only be used following discussion with VGH SIM Team



Eyes

- Blinking eyes
- Pupil replacement sets can be requested for varying conditions



Cardiac

- ECG monitoring with a library of common ECGs (all ACLS rhythms)
- CPR capable

Nursing Skills

- NG and OG tube insertion
- Ostomy care
- Gastrostomy port
- Central line care
- Urinary catheterization
- Bilateral pre-ported IV arms

IM Injection Sites

• Air only

Do not use any staining materials on the skin
